
Dear Mark,

I am in receipt of your request for Public Safety First Aid and CPR approval dated June 7, 2023. In accordance with sections 100023 and 100024 of the California Code of Regulations as well as VCEMS Policy 1601 – PSFA and TCC Training Program Approval, I have reviewed the content of the packet you submitted and found that it meets the minimum requirements for approval. This course curriculum is approved for a period of four (4) years and shall expire on June 30, 2027.

This approval also includes provisions for teaching skills related to PSFA optional skills in accordance with VCEMS Optional Skills policies and procedures.
