Dear Mark,

I am in receipt of your request for Public Safety First Aid and CPR approval dated June 15, 2019. In accordance with sections 100023 and 100024 of the California Code of Regulations as well as VCEMS Policy 1601 – PSFA and TCC Training Program Approval, I have reviewed the content of the packet you submitted and found that it meets the minimum requirements for approval. This course curriculum is approved for a period of four (4) years and shall expire on June 30, 2023.

This approval also includes provisions for teaching skills assistance with administration of epinephrine via auto-injector and assistance with the administration of naloxone. PSFA optional skills, including the administration of nasal naloxone, require specific individual and agency approval by the VCEMS Medical Director, in accordance with VCEMS Policy 1602.
